The Award

Which is why the Peter Lang Young Scholars Award has been set up. Award-winning works will be published free of charge – in both hard copy and e-book formats.

The award will recognise outstanding monographs. Applications will be accepted from young scholars up to the age of 35.

In 2014, the award will be given in four fields (humanities, social sciences, law and economics). Two works from each field will receive the award.

Applications

Applications can be submitted, starting immediately and up to 15 October 2014. Peter Lang Verlag will select the winners of the award who will be notified by 15 November 2014 at the latest and announced on the company's website.

Applications should contain the following documents, compiled into *a single* PDF file:

1. Exposé (up to 1,800 characters)
2. Table of contents
3. Extract from the work (up to 9,000 characters)
4. Information detailing the status of the work and completion date
5. If the publication in question is for qualification purposes: a review or letter of recommendation
6. Author's academic c.v.
